**Measuring:**

All dogs entered in Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16" are required to be measured (except Veteran or JH dogs jumping 16"). Dogs jumping 20" and 20+ are not required to be measured, nor are Veteran or JH dogs that jump 16", nor are Skilled category dogs at any jump height. An exhibitor may request to have their dog measured to determine if the dog should be entered in 20" or 20+, but no height card will be issued for any dog jumping 20" or 20+. Dogs with permanent height cards need not be measured.

**Awards:**

Ribbons will be available for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in all jump heights and in all classes (except Chances where no placements are awarded). Purple qualifying ribbons will be available to all dogs earning qualifying runs. New title ribbons will be available.

**Equipment:**

All equipment will meet NADAC specifications and will include an A-Frame, Dogwalk, (rubber on contacts) Tunnels, Weave poles (24"), wingless jumps, hoops.

**Administration:**

1. Confirmations will be sent by email. Please include your legible email address on your entry.
2. Returned checks will be charged a \$25.00 processing fee.
3. Full refunds prior to closing.
4. Entries pulled after closing (including bitches in season, lame or injured dogs) will be charged a \$25.00 processing fee.
5. Late entries will be allowed, if space permits, at the discretion of the secretary. No refunds will be given if that entry is pulled. Day of trial entries allowed if space permits \$12 per run.

**Check in, Briefing, Judging:**

Arena will be open at 3:00 pm Friday night for setup and check -in. We will offer three titling classes of on Friday night: hoopers followed by 2 rounds of Touch and Go. Trial will begin at 5:30 pm on Friday. Saturday, check in begins at 7:30 am, first dog on line at 8:30 am. Sunday, first dog on line at 8:00 am.

**Class Order:**

Fri – (small to tall) Hoopers; Touch and Go (2 rnds)

Sat – (small to tall) Reg 1 & 2 (EE, OO, NN), Chances, Jumpers, Weavers, Tunnelers

Sun – (tall to small) Jumpers, Regular 1 and 2 (EE, OO, NN), Chances, Tunnelers

## **Directions:**

**Mattox Arena. From North and West** - I-35 South and exit #45 toward K15/Wichita, keep right, turn left onto K15-S /SE Blvd turn right onto W. Market (83<sup>rd</sup> st S.). Site is on your right.

**Mattox Arena From East and South** – I– 35 North and exit #33 KS-53, US81/Mulvane turn right onto KS 53, turn left onto hydraulic/S 16<sup>th</sup>, turn right onto E 95<sup>th</sup> S. Turn left on S Hillside slight right onto E 83<sup>rd</sup> S. Site should be on your left.

## **Site Information:**

The surface indoors is rolled dirt and it is really nice. There are indoor bathrooms. There will be crating space available inside the arena. We ask, when possible, that crates be stacked. Standard 4' by 4' X-pens will be allowed, but only for use by 2 or more dogs. Space is limited, so please keep that in mind. As with every trial any of us have ever attended picking up after your dog{s} is a handler responsibility and must happen. Please help us in keeping the site clean. We will have a few snacks and things at the trial but fast food places are also within a few blocks of the trial site.

This site has a large parking lot and RV's are welcome to park, but hookups are not available.

## **Concessions:**

Our local 4-H group will run a concession stand again this year serving breakfast, lunch & snacks.

## **Motels:**

All Exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the hotel/motel grounds so that these motels/hotels will continue to accept dogs. Check with motels/hotels regarding rates and dog policy when making reservations. We do not guarantee that dogs are accepted.. Make your reservations early to get the best possible deal. RV's are welcome to park at Mattox Arena, but hookups are not available.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

## **An explanation of Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler as follows:**

### **NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER**

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

### **Fun Run**

All dogs must be 18 months or older, registered with NADAC, to participate in fun run. The do not have to be entered in the trial.

### Skilled or Proficient? What do I enter?

First keep a few points in mind.

1. In Skilled you MUST jump your dog at one jump height lower than he would have to jump in Proficient. (Example: If a dog whose **Proficient Standard** jump height is **16**, then in **Skilled** it must be **12"**. If the **Vet Division** is then chosen it MUST jump **8"**).
2. Remember those 5 point Qs you used to get? Those are still available in Skilled regular class. There is a 5 point penalty for dropped bars or time faults under 5 seconds. So you can have a penalty and still get a Q (available in the Regular class only).
3. At the Novice and Open level the points earned in Skilled or Proficient will combine to earn a title. For example: you may enter Novice Regular in Skilled (to test the waters) and earn 15 points then decide to enter the next trial in Proficient where you earn another 20 points. With those 35 points you have earned your NAC with 5 points to spare.
4. Proficient allows for no errors. To Q you must be clean and under time.

### What is 'a la carte' pricing and how do I enter?

To encourage entry of all dogs in your household – young, old and everyone in between – I thought we would try pricing by the run rather than by the package. All runs that you are paying for (all dogs from your household entered) are totaled to find the 'per run' price. This way that older dog that really enjoys and is still capable of a few tunnelers or weavers runs can enter at the same price as your 'package' dog. Or maybe you have a young dog not quite ready for weaves but can do jumpers, touch and go and tunnelers. Total that dog's runs into your household total and bring the 'per run' cost down. Let everyone in your house that can still safely enjoy the game do just that. This way you don't have to feel guilty about leaving them home!

To enter:

1. Use one entry form per dog.
2. Total the runs in each class in the right column. Add the column to get the total runs for that one dog for the weekend.
3. In the bottom part of the chart, total all the runs for each dog entered (use one page for the final calculation) that lives in your household. Find the 'per run' price range. Multiply the total runs for all dogs entered, by the price range. This is the total cost of entry.
